Please note: We have available federal census records of Delaware County on microfilm for 1790, 1800, 1810, 1820, 1830, 1840, 1850, 1860, 1870, 1880, and 1900. We also have the special 1890 military census. The following censuses are typed and indexed: they are relatively easy to search and copy: 1790, 1800, 1810, 1820 and 1830. We also have the index to the 1855 New York State census. All other censuses for which we have copies are unindexed and in manuscript form. These will take considerably more time to search.
